

VPE = Plans, organizes and directs a club program which meets the educational needs of the members

The Important Items

- Help develop Club Success Plan (CSP) early in year using goals set by members
- Promote club officer training
- Organize club contests in Fall/Spring (generally six weeks before District contest)
- Support mentoring program for new members
- Recognize members who are participating in educational program
- Set agenda well in advance - a month at a glance sheet lets members set goals early
- If in doubt - lead by example!

Aim High!

Club Leadership Handbook pp46 says each meeting should have at least three manual speeches

- CC** = 10 projects
- CL** = 10 projects
- ACB** = CC + 2 AC manuals
- ACS** = ACB + 2 AC manuals + BSS/SCS ed sessions
- ACG** = ACS + 2 AC manuals + 1 SC/SL/YL workshop + coach member for first three speeches
- ALB** = CC + CL + 6 months as club officer + participate in official training + help create CSP + 2 SCS/LES ed sessions
- ALS** = ALB + one year as district officer + HPL + club coach/sponsor/mentor or specialist credit
- DTM** = ACG + ALS
